All trash produced in the resort from Housekeeping, Administration, and the Restaurants are recycled, including paper, plastic, glass bottles, and aluminum cans. Jet lag can be a real bummer on your relaxing vacation! Who wants to go a whole week with their internal body clock in the wrong time zone! It usually takes 3-4 days to overcome jet lag naturally, and that could put a big damper on your vacation plans! Even if you are only changing time zones by a few hours, this can have a big effect!

How to prepare for Jet lag

Head to bed an hour or two earlier (or later) for 2-3 days before you leave for your trip. This will start adjusting your internal clock. Make sure you know how many hours of sleep per night your body is used to, and adjust to that.

As soon as you board the plane change your clock to the time zone you are traveling to. This way you can mentally start to prepare for what time it will be when you arrive to your destination. Culture Corner

History of Mariachi Music

Indigenous music was played with rattles, drums, flutes and conch-shell horns as part of religious celebrations prior to the Spanish arrival. The Spanish introduced various other instruments including violins, guitars, harps, brass instruments and woodwinds. These new instruments replaced most of the indigenous instruments. In addition to the instruments, the Spanish also introduced the concept of musical bands.

One of the folk musical styles that was created from the introduction of musical bands was called "Son." Son featured string instruments and was divided into various regional varieties. The state of Jalisco had one of the biggest music scenes at this time, from which modern mariachi music was developed. The common idea of the music and look of mariachi developed in the 20th century as the music moved from regional rural folk to an urban phenomenon that came to represent Mexico. The music was first introduced to Mexico City in 1905. Since then it has continued to grow in popularity, and has become well known as the music that represents the country of Mexico.

We are working with associations and government agencies in both the US and Mexico and are beginning to make progress prosecuting these scam artists. We encourage you to submit any information you may receive from these companies – a contact name, phone number, copies of any documentation - directly to your Club Director Rhonda Mayer. Remember – **DO NOT GIVE THEM ANY MONEY.** Awareness and communication are the best tools for countering fraud!
